MAY 2016 “WELL I HOPE SO...” I hear that spoken many times. It is a way of “praying” without really knowing how to pray based on the Word of God. Here are just two verses that give us a way to pray with authority.

Psalm 38:15 “For I HOPE in You, O Lord; You will answer, O Lord my God.”

Romans 15:13 “May the God of HOPE fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in HOPE.” (These are two of the verses I kept on the 3 x 5 cards while in the hospital)

Here is one verse in the Old Testament and one verse in the New Testament that both speak about hope. This is the authority of the God of hope in your life... it is the power of the Holy Spirit. God's hope which fills you all joy and peace is not just a doctrine or teaching, it is reality. You do not have to just hope so but you can know so.

Here are some updates in our lives in Gamboa....thank you so much for praying for me, our family and church. I have now been at home for four weeks and am increasing daily. The therapist comes three times a week and challenges me to new levels of excercises, swimming and use of a Cross Trainer (like a bicycle that uses both legs and arms). I can now also walk the “best dog in the world” with Ann's help and drive the car in special conditions. Ann is a great encouragement in all of this.

Concerning the activity at the church, we have great leadership and guest speakers. On Sunday May 15th, I spoke for the first time in nine weeks with great encouragement from the congregation. I have resumed my radio programs but have not started back to the prison. Saturday May 21th, fifty people got together for a great work day. They got a lot of work done, had great fellowship and good food.

Several of our young adult are being sent out on missions: one to YouthWith A Mission Discipleship Training School in Costa Rica, one as a doctor on a YWAM ship in New Zealand, one as a pilot in Mozambique and several for the homeless here in Panama.
